Want a Private Lesson?

The Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club is offering the opportunity for our Basic Skills “Learn to Skate” skaters to take a private lesson. These lessons are offered to give the student “one on one” instruction to improve their Basic Skills.

A Professional Staff member or a Junior Coach may be contacted for private lessons.

How it Works!

1. Talk to the instructor after class
2. Come to the office and ask staff for assistance with private lesson scheduling
3. Ask for the professional Staff list
4. Ask for the Fall Ice Schedule
5. You may contact any professional or junior coach listed on the professional staff list
6. Payment for instructor is directly paid to instructor
7. Payment of ice is made to the Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club
8. You may have one lesson a week on any general ice session during the fall
9. Instructor time is scheduled through the instructor
10. Ice time **MUST** be scheduled and paid for in the AAFSC office **BEFORE** starting Lessons.

AAFSC Refund and Credit Policy

There will be no refunds issued for Learn to Skate classes. If a skater drops the class within 14 days of the start of the regular scheduled session, a credit will be issued to the skater's account. After 14 days, a class can be dropped only for medical reasons with a Doctor's note. All credits will be prorated from the date the class is dropped.

Skates, Helmets and Clothing

Rental skates and helmets are available for all classes at no extra charge. Helmets are strongly recommended for skaters under 5 years of age and all beginning skaters. Helmets are limited in number and are available on a first come basis. You may bring your own biking or hockey helmet. Skaters should wear gloves and warm comfortable clothing.
