## Shooting Stars

Shooting Stars is an introduction to freestyle skating for badges 6 and above, presented in a fun group class. Class is conducted on full ice. Skaters will learn a freestyle routine containing jumps and spins as well as continue to improve their skating fundamentals.

## Requirements

Entry to the program requires:

- Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club membership
- passed Basic 6 badge or Coordinator's permission

## Attire

Skaters should come dressed appropriately:

- gloves (slim fitting recommended)
- long hair tied back
- no jeans or baggy pants
- no baggy jackets or tops
- dress in layers so skaters can remove one as needed

## Private Lessons

Skaters who want to improve faster are encouraged to add a private lesson. Private lessons are available on club sessions. Ice and lesson fees are additional. For help setting up lessons contact the Shooting Stars Director.

## Dates & Times

Fall I (6 weeks): 9/11, 9/18, 9/25, 10/2, 10/9, 10/16

Fall II (6 weeks): 10/23, 10/30, 11/6, 11/20, 12/11, 12/18 **No class: 11/13, 11/27 or 12/4**

## Cost

Shooting Stars is 6 weeks for \$192. Cost includes 50 minutes of ice with instruction, plus 45 minutes off ice dance class. (Yearly club membership not included.) Shooting Stars is sold as a package: on and off ice portions not available separately.

There is a \$20 discount per skater if you sign up for both fall sessions before Aug 31. There is a \$10 discount for signing up for one session before Aug 31.

## Off Ice Dance

"Intro to Dance" class is designed to parallel the on ice learning experience. The concept is to encourage your child to translate off ice movement to the ice. Off Ice Dance Director Gina Danene Thompson introduces musicality, basic ballet, positions of the body, carriage of the arms, alignment and creative movement.

## Makeup Classes/Refunds

There are no refunds or credits available for missed Shooting Stars classes. A makeup date and time will be announced for each session.

## Evaluation

Skaters will earn badges as soon as they have achieved the required proficiency for each skill in their level.
