- Craig noted
 - AAFSC is the Top 10 clubs and 7th as published in Skating Magazine
 - Sept 5th the prices of the ice will be going up.

 - Cleaning service:

- Springtime competition is set for May 16 19, 2024, currently in slow mode. The contracts for hotels have been signed.

 - DMC membership/Tri-State Membership meetings, needs alternate. Ann Dougherty is in both. DMC is on zoom.

Office Report: Craig Forsyth

• Report was presented.

The AAFSC Office has been working on the following since the last BOD meeting.

- 1) **SUMMER BASIC SKILLS:** As of Monday August 14th we have 209 skaters registered for 2023/24. This is 47 less than at the same time last year.
- 2) **MEMBERSHIP**: AAFSC membership with USFS as of Monday August 14th has reached 478 members. This is 26 more than last month but 22 less than this time last year. Total USFS membership for 2022/23 (*end of May 2023*) was 590.

- 3) **SUMMER ICE:** The number of skaters for the first eight weeks of Summer 2023 ice is up by 11% over Summer 2022 (*same as reported last month*)
- 4) **2022/23 VOLUNTEER FEES:** \$10,323 in 2022/23 volunteer fees have been collected as of Monday August 14th. During same period last year \$12,000 had been collected.
- 5) **2023/24 LOCKER CONTRACT:** 36 lockers have been contracted for the 2023/24 season. At this time last year 25 lockers had been contracted.
- 6) **MICHIGAN BASIC SKILLS SERIES:** Currently, after 11 competitions with 3 more to go, AAFSC is in first place with 993 points (*at this point last year AAFSC had 865 pts*). Second place is now Greater Kalamazoo SA with 622 points (*Please Note: Kalamazoo earned 423 points in their own competition on July 29th !!).* AAFSC's Brad Newman leads the coaches with 829 points. Second place coach has 306. Many of our skaters rank in the top three in the series in their events. AAFSC will have a number of LTS skaters competing at Holland, MI on August 19th, Southgate, MI on October 8th and the finale in Midland, MI on November 4th.
- 7) **FALL LTS** Registration for Fall 2023 will begin this coming weekend.
- 8) **FALL CLUB ICE** begins Monday August 21st. New ice prices are:
- <u>\$19 Club Ice</u> Monday and Friday 3:15pm to 7:05pm; Tuesday thru Thursday 3:15pm to 6:05pm; Sunday 9:45am to 12:35pm
 - \$13 Club Ice (half sessions) Monday thru Friday 3:15pm to 6:05pm
 - \$14 Pass Thru Monday thru Friday 8:15am to 3:05pm
 - \$ 7 Pass Thru Monday thru Friday 6:15am to 8:15am
- 9) PROPOSED FALL ICE DISCOUNT CREDITS approved by Finance Committee

Single Purchase of ice, can include Club Ice (Sign On) and Pass Thru. Credit for discount will be applied to skater's account within one week. If two or more skaters from same family are included in purchase, credit will go to skater with higher purchase amount. Single purchase only – multiple purchases excluded.

\$500 to \$749 – 5% discount credit \$750 to \$999 – 7.5% discount credit \$1,000 and over – 10% discount credit

10) **EBLASTS:** Our goal is to provide as much information as possible.

In the last month we have sent 24 eblasts. Topics included, Competition Results, Exhibitions, Skate Sharpening, Summer Ice, and Excel Series Qualifiers. The average opening is 76.6.

The highest opening was for news regarding the story about Mary Johanson on the USFS home page with a 82% opening.
