Office Report: Craig Forsyth

- Report was presented.

- 1) **SPRING 2024 BASIC SKILLS:** Spring 2024 registration opened on Monday March 18th. As of Wednesday March 20th, we have 254 skaters registered for.
- 2) **LTS MEMBERSHIP:** As of Wednesday March 20th, we have 708 LTS members. An increase of 43 since last month and 14 from last year.
- 3) **MEMBERSHIP:** AAFSC membership with USFS as of Wednesday March 20th is 555 members (*no growth in the last month*). Total USFS membership for 2022/23 (*end of May 2023*) was 591.
- 4) **SPRING ICE:** Registration for Spring ice (*April/May/ early June*) will open at noon on Monday March 25th.
- 5) **SUMMER ICE:** Request for Summer Ice was submitted to the Cube GM on Thursday February 8th. All Club ice has been approved. This includes the 8:15am, 9:15am and 10:15am Monday thru Friday and the 5:15pm Monday thru Thursday as well as all the requested LTS sessions. So far, I have not heard back regarding our requests for Pass Thru ice.
- 6) **MOI TICKETS:** Sales of MOI tickets are about 17.5% greater than last year (\$2,300). Tickets (*actual viewers*) turned in at shows is about the same as last year
- 7) **SANCTIONS:** USFS sanction has been received for AA Skills & Showcase on June 8th. It should appear on sk8stuff.com this weekend or early next week
- 8) **EBCASTS:** Our goal is to provide as much information as possible. In the last month we have sent 31 eblasts. Topics included Spring LTS, Skate Sharpening, Good Luck wishes for competitions, Testing deadlines and results, Birthdays

and MOI (*Tickets/pictures/clothing/Happy ads*). The average opening is 66.77 with highest being the announcement that MOI pictures by Best Ever Media are in (86%) and the lowest being MOI Videos, Photos and Clothing sales (59%).

- Rebecca Hakansson has been recommended for Pro staff.
